



In 2016 EGUSD voters passed Measure M, the District's first-ever general obligation bond to provide critical funding for school infrastructure improvements at every school across the district.

\$138

EGUSD leveraged Measure M with existing and matching funds for a total of \$614 million in infrastructure improvements in just eight years.

EGUSD saved taxpayers more than \$223 million over the life of the bonds through strong fiscal management and accelerating project delivery, completing projects two years ahead of schedule.
