What are the critical needs/shortcomings?

- Inequities between regions – The title 1 schools don't have the same experiences as the affluent schools. The South Sac schools do not get the attention or the resources as the south elk grove schools. Some families won't be able to answer the survey due to monetary inequity. **FIND A WAY FOR ALL TO ANSWER THE SURVEY.**
- Inclusivity for students with disabilities – inclusive playgrounds, inclusive classrooms. Kids in wheelchairs can't check out books by themselves. The portables are not accessible for wheelchairs. Accessibility to restrooms. Kids in wheelchairs aren't able to play on playgrounds. New playground in Tune Town at Disneyland (research this). Find a solution to get rid of bark and barriers. Invest in play structures where every kid can be included. They stand on the outside because they can't join.
- Equitable facilities
- Stadiums for all – difference in the school spirit between the schools with and without stadiums. Stadiums bring it all together. Number of students that participate more where the schools that have stadium. Shared stadiums. Travel to play a home game. Sometimes is 30 minutes away. Jr programs have to travel as well. Marching bands have to travel to other stadiums. Other districts have a stadiums at every school can generate their own revenue.
 - make sure we know the difference between a stadium and just bleachers. Stadiums has ticket booth, press box, restrooms. Needs to be equitable to other Districts. Every game at LCHS was an away game. Have to get out school early to travel to an away stadium.

- Get rid of Portable buildings as Classrooms- **they are awful**. Not built on slabs. Animals dig and live under the portables. Feral cats, dead skunks, etc. Just a box. No built ins. No accommodations. Teachers have to provide their own furniture. Maintenance cost to keep them upkept. Cost more to heat and cool. Not a long term investment. So old (20 years). Possibly more because of need and spacing. Make sure there is enough space to teach the way we want to teach.

 - A portable is put there to stay. Only when they are falling apart are they going to be replaced. ELOPE programs. Temporary basis – interim house. Need to be more intentional when we put down portables.
- Safety – What are the safety concerns? Feickert tall intimidating black gates. Nobody can scale to get on campus. One side is only a chain link fence and anybody can jump it. Needs to be consistent around the entire campus. Fortified. Student ambulant disabilities, how are they getting out during an active shooter.
- Daylor needs to be a safer campus. There are babies on campus. Needs a single point of access. The campus is not in a safe neighborhood.
- Student flow and automobiles – parents driving down the wrong side of the street just to get out. Drop off and pick off. Needs a safe place to drop off the kids. The release from the neighborhood streets.

- Markofer & Elk Grove HS have the same entrance. People do Uturns. Takes too long for drop off. Donner & Eddy have the same problem. 2 parents have crashed onto the grass. Donner is super impacted right now. Parking is a huge issue. The residents are furious.
- Bus – certain programs and regions have buses, not all. Not South Sac. Strengthen buses should increase safety issues.
- Overcrowding – New High School need – The High Schools are impacted. General concerns with all the new homes being built in the south and east side of Elk Grove and there are no Middle School and/or High Schools in the area. The Elementary Schools there is a track system due to overcrowding. Moving children around every 3 months is not easy. Storage needed for track/year round teachers. The Elementary Schools are so impacted!!!
- Every Classroom should have a sink – Post COVID, wash your hands. A sink with Warm & Cold water. Any project based Classroom. Accessible by the students not just the teachers.
 - SPED inequities – 1 or more bathrooms. Not always have access to changing facilities. Independent learners need to have access to functioning kitchen or laundry facilities. Level 4 Classrooms need to have a bathroom inside like in the kinder classrooms. Some sites are having to use staff bathrooms for diapering kids in wheelchairs.
- Outdoor Learning – Utilize the nearby parks to do outside learning. The Elementary School fields are too upkept to be used for outdoor learning/project based learning.
