## What makes EGUSD special?

- Community
- Diversity
- Reputation of quality programs

## What are the critical needs/shortcomings?

- SPED Adult Transition not all facilities have what they need
  - o Example: Laguna Creek is lacking resources but Valley HS has everything they need!
- Transitional Kindergarten (UTK)
  - o Not enough room
  - Not enough facilities
  - o Current Situation: Moving older kids out of classrooms or to another site to accommodate UTK students
- Franklin ES Although a new school, already too small for the enrollment
- Sheldon HS has no soccer field
- The Middle Schools and High Schools are fairly equal, but the Elementary schools are not. Older schools have not been modernized to the standards of newer schools. Newer schools have small spaces for learning, older schools do not
- EGUSD doesn't charge enough for use of fields or facilities so the district can't afford the landscape maintenance needed to maintain the fields
- NEED MORE FACILITIES
- Need another PAC. Only 2 in the district and they are "100" years old.
- Will there be a section in the FMP that shows the facility use frequency? That will be a separate study.
- Landscape is in dire need.
- Tree roots have cracked concrete on playgrounds.
- Infrastructure of parking lots. Crowded. Pick up and Drop off needs a better flow.
- What is the plan for Old Franklin?
- Amount of students being transferred out of their "home" district. This puts a strain on families with only 1 car or work out of town. It makes it hard to get kids to school. Not enough bus drivers in the district, so not all interdistrict students can take a bus.
- Schools overcrowded should go Year Round
- Facility Capacity is based on the Collective Bargaining Agreement.
- Are there any areas in the district that have declining enrollment?
- Next new Elementary School to be in the Rancho Cordova area.
